

# **International Tournament in Kyokushin Karate among children and adults**

## **Regulations**

### **The document represents an official invitation to the international tournament**

On the 9-10 November 2019 Georgian Full-Contact Karate National Federation holds an international tournament among children and adults in Tbilisi, Georgia.

#### **1. Tournament Goals**

- 1.1. Popularizing Kyokushin Karate in the region;
- 1.2. Strengthening friendship and mutual understanding between athletes of different ages and nationalities engaged in Kyokushin Karate.
- 1.3. Enhancing the skill level of athletes, identifying the strongest fighters;
- 1.4. Attracting children and adults to engage in sport and healthy life style.

#### **2. Tournament Schedule**

- 2.1 09.11.2019 – 12.00 – Reception and accommodation of teams  
14.00 – 17:00 – Mandate committee, and weighing.
- 2.2 10.11.2019 - 10.00 – Start of the "Kata" competition;  
11.00 - Preliminary matches;  
16.30 - Semi-final and final fights;  
18.00 - Award ceremony and closing of the tournament;

#### **3. Admission to the tournament**

- 3.1. Health certificate, confirming that the athlete is allowed to participate in full-contact karate competitions (not older than 3 months).
- 3.2. All participants must provide their birth certificate or a passport;
- 3.3. The trainer's application about participant sportsmen;
- 3.4. Fulfilled Attached Applications.
- 3.4. Clean Doji, neat haircut, short nails and protective guards are obligatory: The groin guard and light shields on shin are mandatory for all categories; The helmet and light hand gloves are required for all categories;
- 3.6. Written certificate of non-pregnant for all female participants.

In case of violation the terms above, the sportsman will not be allowed to the tournament.

## 4. Age and weight categories (Kumite)

4.1. **Preliminary Applications for participating must be sent not later than 24.10.2019.**

4.2. Tournament participants are divided into the following age groups:

10-11; 12 –13; 14-15; 16-17 years old (the participant must achieve a given age not later that the day of the tournament);

### Age group « children », 10-11 years old children of age 10-11

under 30 kg

under 35 kg

under 40 kg

over 40 kg

### Age group « children », 12-13 years old juniors of age 12-13

under 35 kg

under 40 kg

under 45 kg

over 45 kg

### Age group « juniors », 14-15 years old juniors of age 14-15

under 50 kg

under 55 kg

under 60 kg

over 60 kg

### Age group « juniors », 16-17 years old juniors of age 16-17

under 60 kg

under 65 kg

under 70 kg

over 70 kg

**4.2. The tournament organizers reserve the right to change the weight classes after holding the mandate committee.**

**4.3. Girls (Female sportsman under 18 years) will be divided after weighing.**

## 5. Kata (Categories and Rules)

5.1. Participants in KATA will be divided into two age categories: 10-13 age category and 14-17 age category.

5.2. **Age category 10-13:**

Mandatory Program: Kata to choose from – Pinan (I-V).

Free Program: Tsukino, Gekusai-sho, Gekusai-dai, Saiha, Yantsu.

**Age Category – 14-17:**

Mandatory Program: Kata to choose from – Tsukino, Yantsu, Gekisai-dai, Gekusai-sho, Saiha.

Free Program: Seichin, Gariu, Seipai, Kanku, Sushiho.

In case of equal points in the program, a new Kata, different from performed earlier, is added.

5.3. The first circle will be estimated by points, after first circle eight participants will be selected, after the first circle, new draw will be made and the second circle will be estimated by flags (as Kumite rules).

## 6. Tournament rules

6.1 The tournament will be held according to the international rules of Kyokushin Karate.

6.2. Duration:

Preliminary match:

- age 10-11 : 2 min + 1 min + weighing ( difference 2 kg/ absolute – 5kg) + 1 min
- age 12-13 : 2 min + 1 min + weighing (difference 2 kg/ absolute – 5kg) + 1 min
- age 14-15 : 2 min + 1 min + weighing (difference 3 kg/ absolute – 5kg) + 1 min

- age 16-17 : 2 min + 1 min + weighing (difference 3 kg/ absolute – 5kg) + 1 min
- Semi-Final and Final matches:
- age 10-11 : 2 min + 1 min + weighing (difference 2 kg/ absolute – 5kg) + 1 min
  - age 12-13 : 2 min + 1 min + weighing (difference 2 kg/ absolute – 5kg) + 1 min
  - age 14-15: 2 min+1 min+1 min+weighing(difference 3 kg/absolute – 5kg) + 1 min
  - age 16-17: 2 min+1 min+1 min+weighing (difference3 kg/absolute – 5kg) + 1 min

6.3. Notice: if not more than 3 participants are in one weight category, the matches will be conducted round robin.

6.4. Only 2 fighter from Country in each weight category (Organizer Country has more participants).

## 7. Judging

7.1. The tournament will be judged by the judges assigned by the organizing committee of the tournament (The main referee – Mikheil Tsiklauri).

7.2. The **uniform** of Judge – blue shirt, white bow, black trousers.

## 8. Awards

8.1 Athletes who take first, second and third places, will be awarded with diplomas, medals, cups and special prizes.

## 9. Financing the tournament

9.1. All costs associated with organizing the tournament will be covered by Georgian Full-contact Karate National Federation.

9.2. Organizers will cover accommodation for each team (only directed members): 2 fighter in each weight category + 1 official (coach/country representative) + 1 judge.

9.3. There is no entry fee for participation in tournament.

9.4. Travel costs are covered by the sending organization.
